Just over a thousand people live on the twenty square kilometres that make up this exquisite and delightful island, untouched by any sign of mass tourism. A haven of restfulness and tranquillity, there is little to disturb the simple pleasures of sun, sand and crystal clear waters.

Gentle tracks lead through terraces of olive groves down to undisturbed beaches; cascades of bougainvillaea blaze against the whitewashed houses in the three sleepy villages. Walking through the gentle rolling countryside is a popular activity.

The ports and villages are all linked by a circular road which runs above the sea and then winds its way inland through an idyllic country landscape. Most its beaches are of white-pebble, backed by pine and cypress. Ai Yiannis, also linked by country road from Spartohori, is the best known in the west and has a taverna – views to Lefkas are exquisite.

This is an island from which to forget the cares of the world, one where you can completely relax and lose yourself in magnificent views, walking, swimming and other simple pleasures.

Limonari Bay

LIMONARI

Katomeri is the small island capital of Meganissi and the cove of Limonari is at the end of a narrow, 1km road which winds down from the village. Here there are two beaches, Mikro (small) Limonari and Megalo (large) Limonari. The sand/pebble beaches here are fringed with olive and pine trees and the waters clear and inviting. These are uncrowded beaches with no facilities or tavernas.

Katomeri, with a population of around 500 persons has a petrol station, bakery and a few tavernas and is very much a traditional village with stone built houses and courtyards bedecked with colourful potted plants. Port Vathy is a drive of about 10 minutes from this area.



Spartohori

SPARTOHORI

The village of Spartohori with approximately 500 inhabitants, is perched high above the little port of Spilia in Spilia Bay and enjoys dramatic views across the sea to the mountains of the Greek mainland.

This is a sleepy and very pretty village, with its narrow streets of cobblestones and whitewashed houses bordered by flowers. It is a 10 to 15 minute walk up the road or via a series of steps from the port.

Here you will find two tavernas, one pizzeria and two mini markets. Spilia port has three waterfront tavernas and a sheltered pebble beach, backed by olive trees, just round the corner. A hired boat can be moored at Spilia.

Tiny Vathy, on the North coast of the island, is the main ferry port on Meganissi and is about 6km south east of the larger island of Lefkas. Fishing boats and visiting yachts moor alongside the waterfront houses, tavernas and shops. A good spot to watch the comings and goings in the harbour.

A coastal road winds through the island's beautiful landscape of olive groves and pine trees, leading to secluded beaches and coves and connects Meganissi's three main villages. An area which is good for walking and cycling.

THE LIMONARI VILLAS

LIMONARI • MEGANISSI

A narrow road of one kilometre winds its way down a hillside of olive groves from the sleepy island capital of Katomeri to the beautifully clear sea at Limonari on Meganissi's south-east coast. Just a few metres away from the sea and two small beaches, the Limonari Villas look out to the island of Kalamos, the mountains of the Greek mainland and along Meganissi's east coast.

Set on separate levels of the hillside, each of the three villas has a large sea-facing pool terrace with stunning, uninterrupted views. The pool areas do not overlook another. These are some of our best selling properties.

A small, secluded beach is a one minute walk away and a larger beach is a three minute walk away. Katomeri, a drive of five minutes, has a bakery and a few tavernas. Vathy is a drive of ten minutes and has three supermarkets, four waterside tavernas, a pizzeria and ouzeri.

VILLA KALLISTI NEAR SPARTOHORI • MEGANISSI

Villa Kallisti is the latest addition to our programme from the owner of two of our most popular villas – Dafni and Eleni. It is a five minute walk from the charming village of Spartohori. The views from the extensive terrace and pool area are over the Bay of Spilia and to the mainland beyond.

The villa has it's own private entrance from a narrow lane and, for those who know the area, Kallisti is slightly closer to the village. It is in a quiet, rural position, surrounded by olive trees yet only a five minute walk to the tiny hilltop village with its narrow streets of cobblestone and whitewashed houses bordered by flowers.

A further 10 minute walk from the village brings you to the little fishing port of Spilia with its two waterfront tavernas and sheltered beach. Many other beaches can be reached using the local boat hire service.
