ANTIPAXOS

Just seven miles long and three miles wide, Paxos encapsulates the magical beauty and variety of the Ionian: over 30 sheltered beaches on the east coast, dramatic cliffs on the west, olive trees and tall pines inland, surrounded by the clearest crystal waters, and fringed with caves, grottoes and unpopulated islands.

About half of the island's population of 3,000 live in the three villages of Gaios, Logg os and Lakka, and help create that special sense of serenity, sociability and relaxation that characterises Paxos.

GAIOS

Gaios is the main village of Paxos. Rare among Greek islands, the little flagstoned square with its church is right on the water. The village is a maze of narrow streets lined with an assortment of little shops, tavernas and bars. A host of attractive bays and coves lie nearby. Boats, to reach the sandy beaches of Antipaxos, depart from the square every morning.

MAGAZIA

At the heart of Paxos, the small village of Magazia has come into its own over recent years. It has grown from a charming rural community to a central hub whose magnetic pull attracts locals and visitors from all over the island. Its far reaching views and the juxtaposition of traditional and contemporary, as well as the excellent bakery and grill restaurant, make it well worth the short detour from the coast.



Loggos

LOGGOS

The smallest and most attractive fishing village on Paxos, Loggos remains unspoilt. Thirty little houses cluster around the old platia which is right on the sea. Silver and green olive groves cover the hills surrounding the village. Tavernas serve good food and small shops provide a wide range of groceries. Waterfront café bars offer delightful vantage points for people and boat watching. Good bathing from beaches and rocks is within five minutes' walk.

LAKKA

The little port of Lakka with its almost circular harbour and crystal clear sea, framed by green and silver olive trees, is an artist's delight.

Narrow streets, picturesque gardens, numerous small shops, tavernas, bars and friendly people give Lakka a special character of its own. Lakka's wide bay of clear, turquoise waters contains a stretch of olive-fringed beaches, which shelve to sand.

ANTIPAXOS

An undulating interior of hillsides, carpeted by maquis, contains small vineyards above beaches of sand and pebble. A network of narrow tracks lead from the small harbour of Agrapidia up to the interior and past the occasional cottage with gardens of fruit trees, vegetables and vineyards. Pathways, bordered by large bulbs of sea squill and wild herbs, lead down on the east coast to the sandy bays of Voutoumi and Vrika with their chalk-blue waters.

There are four tavernas but no shops on Antipaxos.

VILLA YAKOVOS

NEAR GAIOS • PAXOS

There are plenty of beautiful villas on Paxos, but few offer the kind of view you get at Villa Yakovos. It's best taken in from the pool terrace or first-floor balcony – a broad vista that runs down over forested hills to the blue Ionian Sea, and out to Antipaxos. If your idea of villa heaven is relaxing with a cool drink while the sun sinks spectacularly into the sea, the pool terrace of Villa Yakovos is the place to be.

While Gaios is only a short drive away, Villa Yakovos is deep in Paxos's wild south, set in expansive grounds and surrounded by olive groves. The feeling of seclusion is total, but the small village of Ozias is just a short stroll away, and has a handy shop-cafébar run by the villa's owner. Paxos's small scale makes exploring further afield easy – great local walks include the scenic path to Trypitos Arch, and the road from Ozias to the sandy, family-friendly beach at Moggonissi.

Back at the villa, a spacious, modern living area and a large pool terrace create the perfect atmosphere for a relaxed family or small group holiday.

POSEIDON'S NEST

Set on a cliff edge with infinite views, perhaps Eagles Nest would have been more apt. Olive groves surround the property and the private terraced gardens have an intimate feel.

Across the sea one can see Antipaxos and on a clear day even Lefkas appears on the horizon. Sunsets with Antipaxos in the foreground are unforgettable.

This is a quiet place, with the winds and the waves to keep you company and the silence disturbed only by the song of the cicadas.

Gaios is only a 10 minute drive as are nearby beaches. A boat can be hired and moored in Gaios.

THE OLIVE PRESS NEAR GAIOS • PAXOS

There's a lot to love about The Olive Press. Its location balances a secluded spot in the unspoilt south with easy access to the pretty port of Gaios. And its accommodation is packed with character – this is a centuries-old working building, and incorporates traditional stone walls and parts of the original olive-pressing floor. Romantic in every sense, it's the perfect choice for couples who want to relax into the slow, peaceful rhythms of Paxos life.

By day, kick back on the sunny terrace, take a dip in the pool or head out on foot to explore the area on the old donkey tracks and quiet country lanes. Both east and west coasts are within easy reach – Gaios is 15 minutes on foot or five minutes by car, and a short walk will bring you to the beautiful beach at Avlaki or the Trypitos Arch, a striking and remote rock formation.

In the evening, an open-plan living area allows you to cook and chill out together, and an enclosed, beautifully lit patio creates the perfect environment for romantic al fresco meals. Alternatively, try out one of the two excellent tavernas just a short stroll away.
